

Assistant Professor, Teaching Stream - Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery

Application Deadline: January 15, 2018

The Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, invites applications for a full-time teaching stream position in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. The appointment will be at the rank of Assistant Professor, Teaching Stream and will begin on July 1, 2018.

Applicants must have: 1) a DDS/DMD degree or equivalent, 2) a graduate degree, and 3) have successfully completed specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in a program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada or the Commission on Dental Accreditation in the United States. Applicants must be eligible for or have completed: 1) the National Dental Specialty Examination administered by the Royal College of Dentists of Canada; 2) Fellowship in the College; 3) licensure in Ontario as a recognized specialist in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery; and 4) an appointment at a University of Toronto affiliated teaching hospital.

We seek enthusiastic and innovative individuals with both the demonstrated ability and ambition to enhance the domestic and international reputation of our programs, and significantly add to the quality of the student experience. Teaching excellence is required as evidenced by a robust teaching statement and strong letters of reference from individuals of high standing, as well as previous experience teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate program level as evidenced in the teaching dossier and teaching statement submitted for review. A demonstrated record of scholarly activity and a commitment to pedagogical enquiry and teaching innovation in the field of educational research is also required.

The successful candidate must demonstrate the potential to develop and direct the graduate specialty program in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, and have appropriate clinical experience. As well, the successful candidate will be expected to supervise graduate students and teach at the didactic and clinical levels in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.
